OCC Week-Long Tour Announcement

Since 1985, the purple and teal have taken an extended bicycle ride to further explore the more distant roads of New York State. Recently, the club has extended into Pennsylvania and Vermont. This year, on July 11-18, we're going to Canada to cycle along the St. Lawrence River, explore the Rideau Lakes chain, and get a taste of rural, as well as, cosmopolitan Ontario.

The touring covers between 50 and 70 miles each day. We stay in hotel/motels along the route and a van usually accompanies the group to carry luggage, a few spares and provides sag support.

The tentative itinerary currently includes overnight stays in Sackett's Harbor, Kingston, Gananoque, and Perth . Kingston will serve as a base for three days of riding, not to mention, sightseeing, dining and pub-crawling. A passport, or birth certificate, is required to enter/exit Canada [via the Cape Vincent-Wolfe Island ferry].

The tour is limited to twenty people and a deposit of twenty dollars will reserve your spot. These moneys are non-refundable and will be used for the sag support. Earth Day Clean-up a Success




